POWER AND ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES		MECHANISMS FOR SETTING PAY OFFS
Between individuals & within households	Allocation of food (e.g. who eats first) & other rewards. Responsibility for looking after children.	Crop/livestock yields, food, shelter & care
Within family & kin	Obligations - gifts, loans, employment, shelter	Prices of wage goods: wage rates, interest rates (official & informal)
Between classes & groups	Patron-client relations (obligations, services): taboo: untouchability: share-cropper/landlord relations: rules about property & theft	
Between individuals & the State	Law & order: allocation of famine/disaster relief: relief from taxation
