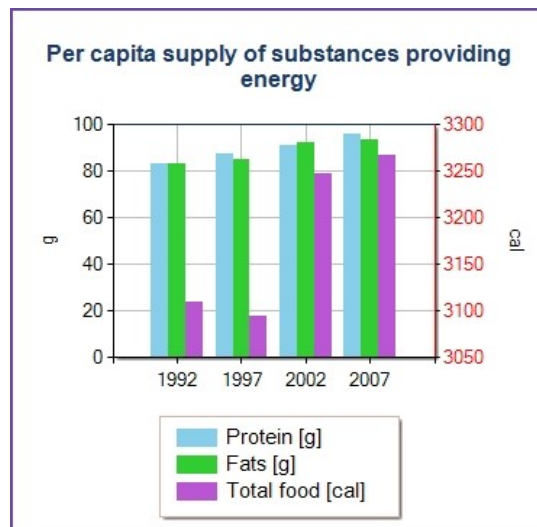

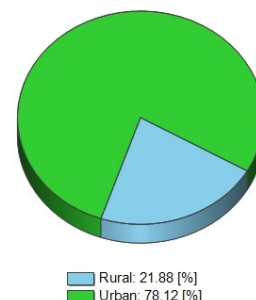

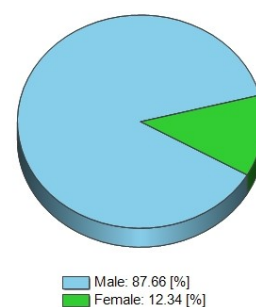
Rural and urban population - 2011

Gender in agricultural Labour Force - 2011

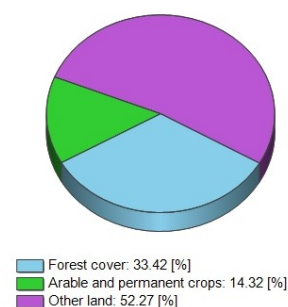

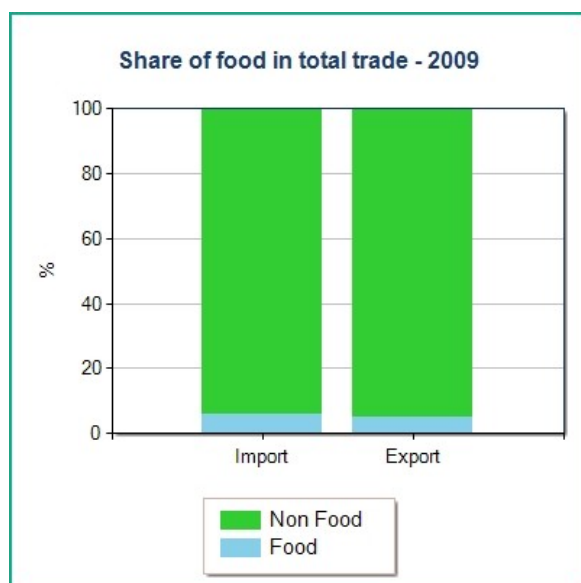

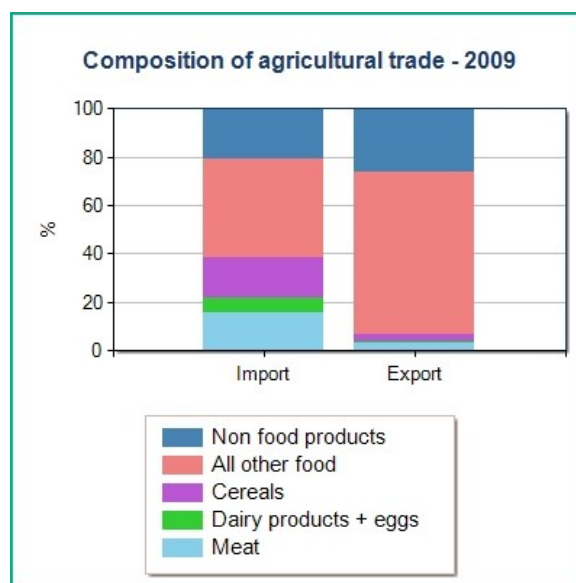
